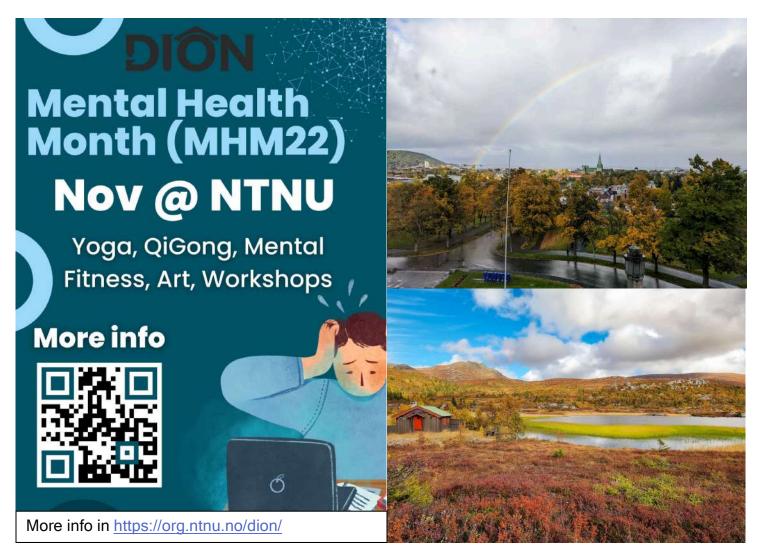

Frykter frislipp vil bety færre stipendiater

EN: Fears that new regulation may lead to fewer PhD Candidates

DION's president Regina Matveeva shared her thoughts about cutting off the ear marking for PhD and PostDoc positions at Norwegian universities. I.e., the universities themselves can decide how many fellows they would like to hire. While the universities see this as a flexibility, Regina is concerned that the money will be distributed differently, resulting in fewer positions existing in the future. Regina believes only time can tell how it will turn out. She hopes that universities will not scale back the number of positions if the number of PhD graduates remains as one of the indicators for performance of the university.

EN: PhD Candidates call for a neutral mediator when the cooperation with the supervisor crashes

During an interview with Khrono, a Norwegian independent newspaper for higher education and research, DION board member W. Ludwig Kuhn described his experiences with changing a supervisor. He has first-hand experience as well as knowledge from cases that are known to DION. In addition to clear rules for changing a supervisor, a neutral mediator at NTNU is proposed to solve more severe conflicts to avoid the department or faculty from taking side with the supervisor.

Tekna NTNU and DION invite to a seminar on November 24, 15:00-18:00 in K105 in the Kobolt building. The seminar program is as follows:

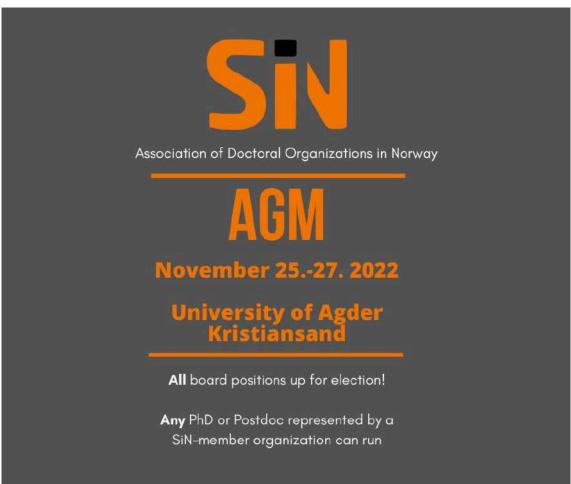
- Working in Norway how does the Norwegian Model work, and why are unions so important here?
